The Cape Women's Agricultural Association was established on 15 October 1929 in Franschhoek.

The head office is situated at Jubilee House, 126 Dorp Street, Stellenbosch, South Africa

In 1931, the three-legged pot was accepted as the official logo with the following slogan: *For Hearth and Home*.

The official publication, *Hearth and Home*, has been published since May 1952.
